WORMERIES



Pseudoscorpion

Resembling scorpions with their large pincers but at rarely more than 3-4mm they lack the stinging tail.

Springtail

Using their spring loaded 'furcula' they can jump 10cm (despite being less than 6mm long).



Brandling / Tiger worm

Bright red in colour these 'detritivores' feed mainly on partly decomposed plant material.
